SCHOOL TIMES AND LATENESS

School starts at 8.50, however;

- Children may come to their class via their class entrance from 8.40am
- Please note children should not be on school site before 8.30am
- All children in R, Yr1 and Yr2 should be escorted into school by an adult to ensure safety.
- Registration is at 8.50am, if your child arrives after this time they should enter via the school office.

If a child is late it is not only disruptive for the class but can be upsetting for the child. Parents should also be aware that children who are late often miss valuable teaching time as lessons start straight after registration. Lateness will be closely monitored and if it is persistent parents/carers will be invited into school to discuss the reasons for this. A reminder that new Government guidelines do not permit us to authorise any family holidays during term time.

PARENTS MEETINGS

Our Parents Evening will be held on Wednesday 7th February from 2pm-7pm. A letter giving full information will be sent to you nearer the time. There will be an Internet Safety workshop held on Tuesday 6th February 2.30-3pm which will take place in the school hall. SCHOOL UNIFORM

May I kindly remind you that all children should come to school wearing the correct uniform. Trainers are not permitted as every day footwear and shoes should be black. Extreme hairstyles are also not appropriate for school and hair accessories should be in uniform colours.

Please note we are unable to let parents and young children into the school for access to a toilet. There is however a toilet on the premises available to use. This is situated around the corner from the main school office, 3rd door on the right.
